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

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1128, L.D. 1559, Bill, "An Act To Reduce Energy Costs, Increase Energy Efficiency, Promote Electric System Reliability and Protect the Environment"

Amend the bill in part A in section 20 in subsection 4-A in the 7th line (page 7, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "rule." the following: 'The commission may not increase any assessment or increase rates under this subsection until the Legislature has approved the trust's budget.'

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that the Public Utilities Commission may not increase any assessment or increase rates under the subsection governing procurement of cost-effective energy efficiency resources until the Legislature has approved Efficiency Maine Trust's budget.
