An Act To Increase the Maximum Gas Safety Administrative Penalty Amounts

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §4516-A, sub-§§1 and 2**, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 505,
3 §35, are amended to read:

4 **1. Violation of this Title.** The commission may impose an administrative penalty
5 on a natural gas pipeline utility that violates any provision of this Title relating to safety
6 of pipeline facilities or transportation of gas or any rule issued under this Title in an
7 amount not to exceed ~~\$100,000~~ \$200,000 for each violation. Each day of violation
8 constitutes a separate offense.

9 **2. Maximum administrative penalty.** The maximum administrative penalty may
10 not exceed ~~\$1,000,000~~ \$2,000,000 for any related series of violations.

11 **Sec. 2. 35-A MRSA §4705-A, sub-§§1 and 2**, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 505,
12 §38, are amended to read:

13 **1. Violation of this Title.** The commission may impose an administrative penalty
14 on a gas utility that violates any provision of this Title relating to safety of gas facilities
15 or any rule issued under this Title in an amount not to exceed ~~\$100,000~~ \$200,000 for each
16 violation. Each day of violation constitutes a separate offense.

17 **2. Maximum administrative penalty.** The maximum administrative penalty may
18 not exceed ~~\$1,000,000~~ \$2,000,000 for any related series of violations.

19 **SUMMARY**

20 This bill increases the maximum gas safety administrative penalty amounts to be
21 consistent with federal law.
