4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill would create a program to provide voluntary workplace training to certain
6 eligible unemployment insurance beneficiaries. The bill would establish criteria to
7 identify eligible participants and eligible employers and would ensure that those
8 participants continue to receive benefits while participating in the program.
