4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to provide that a student placed in legal guardianship is eligible for
6 free meals under the school lunch and milk program in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title
7 20-A, chapter 223, subchapter 7 without considering the income of the student's guardian.
