13 lines 9 to 12 in L.D.).

Amend the bill in section 3 in §6173-B by renumbering the subsections to read  
15 consecutively.

This amendment, which is the unanimous report of the committee, strikes the  
18 provision in the bill that specifies that information collected by any governmental entity  
19 other than the Department of Marine Resources is not confidential.
