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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1211, L.D. 1688, Bill, "An Act To Streamline Enforcement of Child Support Orders Issued by the Penobscot Nation"

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Amend the bill in section 1 in §2459-A in subsection 4 in the 8th line (page 2, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Penobscot Nation Tribal" and inserting the following: 'Superior'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment provides that an appeal of the Secretary of State's suspension of an operator's license must be filed in Superior Court, not the Penobscot Nation Tribal Court.
