1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Department of Health and Human Services; Homeless Youth**
3 **Program.** The Department of Health and Human Services must allocate funds available
4 in the Homeless Youth Program based on the proportion of the total amount each
5 geographic region received during fiscal year 2012-13. The department may not
6 reallocate funds from one geographic region to another.

7 **Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and
8 allocations are made.

9 **HOUSING AUTHORITY, MAINE STATE**

10 **Shelter Operating Subsidy 0661**

11 Initiative: Provides funds for homeless shelters to offset a reduction in federal funding.

17 **SUMMARY**

18 This bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services to allocate funds
19 available in the Homeless Youth Program based on the proportion of the total amount
20 each geographic region received during fiscal year 2012-13 and prohibits the department
21 from reallocating funds between geographic regions.

22 The bill provides a General Fund appropriation of \$750,000 in fiscal year 2014-15 for
23 the Maine State Housing Authority to provide funding for homeless shelters.
