SUMMARY

8 Under the provisions of State of Maine v. Philip Morris, et al., Kennebec County
9 Superior Court, Docket No. CV-97-134, Maine will receive a one-time disbursement.
10 Allocations from or in relation to this lawsuit are, pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes,
11 Title 22, section 1511, limited to the prevention and health promotion purposes of
12 smoking prevention, cessation and control activities, including, but not limited to,
13 reducing smoking among the children of the State; prevention, education and treatment
14 activities concerning unhealthy weight and obesity; prenatal and young children's care
15 including home visits and support for parents of children from birth to 6 years of age;
16 child care for children up to 15 years of age, including after-school care; health care for
17 children and adults, maximizing to the extent possible federal matching funds;
18 prescription drugs for adults who are elderly or disabled, maximizing to the extent
19 possible federal matching funds; dental and oral health care to low-income persons who
20 lack adequate dental coverage; substance abuse prevention and treatment; and
21 comprehensive school health and nutrition programs, including school-based health
22 centers.

23 This bill allocates funds from the disbursement in accordance with Title 22, section
24 1511 for smoking prevention and health promotion programs, such as education
25 regarding the use of marijuana, the improvement of tobacco and substance abuse policies,
26 an education campaign regarding family planning and reproductive health and grants for
27 an outreach campaign on the impact of food and beverage choices on obesity.
