16 17 18 19 20	Sec. 4. Contingent effective date. Those sections of this Act that enact the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 200-J and repeal Title 25, section 1505-A do not take effect unless sufficient federal funding becomes available to support the costs of the cold case homicide unit. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall notify the Secretary of State and the Revisor of Statutes when sufficient federal funding is available.'

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the General Fund and Highway Fund appropriations and allocations from the bill. It directs the Commissioner of Public Safety and the Attorney General to pursue federal funding for the cost of the cold case homicide unit. It establishes an effective date contingent upon the receipt of sufficient federal funding.
