SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1253, L.D. 1746, Bill, "An Act To Facilitate Informed Planning for Higher Education and Careers"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 2 the following:

Sec. 3. Lapsed balances; Legislature, General Fund account.
Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the State Controller shall lapse \$2,500 from the All Other line category from the Legislature, General Fund account in the Legislature to the General Fund unappropriated surplus no later than June 30, 2015.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment offsets the General Fund appropriation of \$2,500 to the Legislature in fiscal year 2014-15 with the requirement that \$2,500 lapses from the Legislature, General Fund account to the unappropriated surplus in fiscal year 2014-15.
