
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1320, L.D. 1831, Bill, "An Act To Allow Signs for Areas of Local, Regional and Statewide Interest on the Interstate System"

Amend the bill in section 3 in §1912-C by inserting after subsection 5 the following:

'6. Grandfathered signs. Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the contrary, this section does not apply to a supplemental guide sign that was lawfully installed prior to July 1, 2014.'

SUMMARY

This amendment exempts from the provisions of the bill those signs that were lawfully installed prior to July 1, 2014.
