#### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

This bill exempts from sales tax sales of the United States flag as long as the flag is made of cloth. It would result in a loss of General Fund revenue of \$93,337 in fiscal year 2015-16 and \$129,926 in fiscal year 2016-17 and a loss to the Local Government Fund of \$4,913 in fiscal year 2015-16 and \$6,838 in fiscal year 2016-17.
