

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1907, first ¶**, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 683, Pt. A, §2 and
3 affected by Pt. B, §5, is amended to read:

4 A vehicle, including a device propelled or drawn by a horse during nighttime, must
5 be equipped with at least one adequate reflector securely attached to the rear. The
6 reflector:

8 This bill clarifies that vehicles propelled or drawn by a horse and operated at night
9 must have a rear reflector.
