1 **Sec. 1. Dyslexia awareness and student accommodation. Resolved:** That
2 the Department of Education, referred to in this resolve as "the department," shall train
3 school personnel to implement dyslexia awareness and student accommodation policies;
4 and be it further

5 **Sec. 2. Rulemaking. Resolved:** That the department shall amend its rules to
6 implement this resolve. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules
7 under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
