COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 44, L.D. 50, Bill, "An Act To Authorize up to 3 Free Sets of License Plates for 100 Percent Disabled Veterans"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Authorize up to 2 Free Sets of License Plates for 100 Percent Disabled Veterans'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 in the first paragraph in the 4th line from the end (page 1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "3" and inserting the following: '2'

SUMMARY

Current law provides that a 100% disabled veteran may receive, at no fee, a registration certificate and set of special designating plates for one vehicle. This amendment provides that a 100% disabled veteran may receive, at no fee, a registration certificate and set of special designating plates for each of up to 2 vehicles rather than 3 vehicles as proposed in the bill.
