It retains the provision in the bill that allows the Town of Berwick in York County to be designated as a Pine Tree Development Zone tier 1 location in order to allow the town to be eligible for Pine Tree Development Zone benefits.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill expands the Pine Tree Development Zone program to include the Towns of Berwick and Sanford. It is not expected that a qualified project would be certified before fiscal year 2017-18, therefore the General Fund and Local Government Fund revenue loss does not begin until outside the biennium.

Additional costs to the Department of Economic and Community Development associated with implementing the requirements of this legislation can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
