1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1355-A, sub-§6, ¶G,</b> as enacted by PL 2013, c. 345, §4, is amended to read:
4 5	G. Only one <u>No more than 9</u> tenant brewer <u>license</u> <u>licenses</u> may be issued per host brewer licensed under subsection 3.
6	SUMMARY
7 8 9	Current law allows a person licensed to manufacture malt liquor to host one tenant brewer at that person's manufacturing facility. This bill amends that law to allow for up to 9 tenant brewers per host at a manufacturing facility.
