1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1355-A, sub-§6, ¶G,** as enacted by PL 2013, c. 345, §4, is
3 amended to read:

4 G. ~~Only one~~ No more than 9 tenant brewer ~~license~~ licenses may be issued per host
5 brewer licensed under subsection 3.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 Current law allows a person licensed to manufacture malt liquor to host one tenant
8 brewer at that person's manufacturing facility. This bill amends that law to allow for up
9 to 9 tenant brewers per host at a manufacturing facility.
