Sec. 1. Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to establish a daily 1 bag limit on trout, landlocked salmon and togue for Webster Stream in 2 3 Piscataquis County. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall amend Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Rule Chapter 1: Open 4 Water and Ice Fishing Regulations to establish for Webster Stream in Piscataquis County 5 from the Telos Lake dam downstream to Webster Lake a daily bag limit of one trout, one 6 7 landlocked salmon and one togue effective between August 16th and September 30th 8 annually.

SUMMARY

10 This resolve directs the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to amend 11 Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife Rule Chapter 1: Open Water and Ice 12 Fishing Regulations to establish for Webster Stream in Piscataquis County from the Telos 13 Lake dam downstream to Webster Lake a daily bag limit of one trout, one landlocked 14 salmon and one togue effective between August 16th and September 30th annually.
