COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 124, L.D. 166, Bill, "An Act To Allow York County To Better Provide Rescue and Ambulance Services"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act To Allow Counties To Better Provide Rescue and Ambulance Services'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §456 by striking out all of the indented paragraph (page 1, lines 6 to 8 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

'Each county may provide rescue services through the sheriff's department and deputies.'

SUMMARY

18

This amendment is the minority report of the committee and replaces the substance of the bill, which applies only to York County. It changes the title and removes language in current law that provides that a county may provide rescue services through the sheriff's department and deputies and instead provides that each county may provide rescue services.
