1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §456**, as enacted by PL 1987, c. 737, Pt. A, §2 and Pt. C,
3 §106 and amended by PL 1989, c. 6; c. 9, §2; and c. 104, Pt. C, §§8 and 10, is further
4 amended to read:

5 **§456. Rescue services**

6 Each county may provide rescue services through the sheriff's department and
7 deputies except that York County may provide for rescue services pursuant to section
8 457.

9 **SUMMARY**

10 This bill allows York County Government to provide rescue services pursuant to the
11 law governing counties' provision of ambulance services.
