1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §1973, sub-§6 is enacted to read:
3	6. Use by gold star parents. The authority shall waive tolls on the turnpike for a
4	person who is a resident of this State and who is a parent eligible to receive a gold star
5	lapel button under 10 United States Code, Section 1126 (2010). The authority shall issue
6	a windshield placard to a person for whom tolls are waived under this section.
7	SUMMARY
8	This bill requires the Maine Turnpike Authority to waive tolls on the Maine Turnpike
9	for a person who is a Maine resident and who is a parent eligible to receive a gold star
10	lapel button under 10 United States Code, Section 1126 (2010).
