28	This amendment strikes and replaces the bill. Like the bill, it shortens the time
29	requirement for the physical examination of a child ordered into the custody of the

31	of the child commences to 3 days. The bill strikes the provision requiring under certain
32	conditions a psychological assessment within 30 days of the required physical
33 34	examination. This amendment restores that requirement. It also requires the department to adopt routine technical rules that allow for reimbursement under MaineCare for a
