COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 83, L.D. 214, Bill, "An Act To Stay Certain Suspensions Imposed by the Secretary of State Pending Appeal"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2-A in the 4th line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "recklessly or" and inserting the following: '~~recklessly or~~'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2-A in the last line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "subsection 4"

SUMMARY

This amendment amends current law governing driver's license suspensions to remove a reference to reckless operation since a suspension is determined by the Secretary of State's application of the lesser civil standard of negligent operation. The amendment also makes a technical correction to the bill.
