2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6601, sub-§5-A,</b> as amended by PL 2009, c. 213, Pt. G, §14, is further amended to read:
4 5	<b>5-A. Exception.</b> The fee for a commercial shellfish license for applicants 70 years of age or older <u>and applicants under 18 years of age</u> is \$67.

7 8	This bill reduces a commercial shellfish license for persons under 18 years of age to \$67.
