1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §903-D is enacted to read:
3	§903-D. Limitation on circulators of petitions
4 5 6	A person collecting signatures on a petition for the direct initiative of legislation or a people's veto referendum must have been a resident of the State for at least one year prior to the beginning of the collection process.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	This bill limits the collecting of signatures on petitions for the direct initiative of legislation or a people's veto referendum to persons who have been residents of the State for at least one year.
