| 12 13 | Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following: |
| 14 15 | 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and |
| 16 17 | Whereas, many taxpayers when they file income tax returns request a fuel tax refund for fuel purchased for off-highway purposes such as farming and fishing; and |
| 18 19 | Whereas, it is important to change the period for which refund requests may be made during the income tax filing period ending April 15, 2015; and |
| 20 21 22 23 | Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,' |
| 24 | Amend the bill by adding before the summary the following: |
| 25 26 | 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.' |

| 28 | This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill. |
