14	'Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6674, as amended by PL 2009, c. 229, §18, is repealed and the	
15	following enacted in its place:	
16	<u>§6674. Interference with municipal shellfish aquaculture permit</u>	
17	1. Prohibition. A person may not know	owingly interfere with the ability of a person
18	who holds a municipal shellfish aquaculture permit to carry out the privileges granted to	
19	the permittee under that permit. Except for the permittee or the permittee's designee, a	
20	person may not take, disturb or molest any shellfish in the intertidal zone in the area that	
21	is included in a municipal shellfish aquacult	ure permit.
22	2. Penalty. A person who violates this	section commits a civil violation for which a
23	fine of not less than \$500 nor more than \$1.0	000 may be adjudged.
24	3. Restitution. In addition to the penal	ty under subsection 2, if a person violates this
25	section by interfering with the ability of a person who holds a municipal shellfish	
26	aquaculture permit to carry out the privileges granted to that permittee under that permit,	
27	the court shall:

8. of S.	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 93, L.D. 255	
1	SUMMARY	
2	This amendment replaces the bill. Unlike the bill, it excludes the designee of a holder	
3	of a municipal shellfish aquaculture permit from potential liability for taking, disturbing	
4	or molesting any shellfish on the permit site. This amendment reduces the maximum	
5	penalty for a person who interferes with the ability of a permittee to carry out the	
6	privileges granted under the permit from \$2,000, as provided in the bill, to \$1,000 and	
7	provides restitution by that person to the permittee in an amount equal to twice the	
8	replacement value of any damaged equipment on the permit site.
