4	A. Hunt wild animals or wild birds on Sunday, except as provided in subsection 3; or

6 7 8 9	3. Exception. A person licensed under this chapter may hunt on Sundays during the month of November on public lands greater than 10 acres in size that are open to hunting or on private property greater than 10 acres in size with the consent of the property owner.
