4 5 6	E. Steam heating boilers, hot water heating boilers and hot water supply boilers, with the exception of boilers located in schoolhouses or boilers owned by municipalities constructed and installed in accordance with the rules adopted by the director; or
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	This bill reestablishes the requirement, eliminated by Public Law 2013, chapter 595 that boilers in schools and boilers owned by municipalities be inspected to ensure their proper performance.
