COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 123, L.D. 308, Bill, "An Act To Cap Fines Imposed for Certain Motor Carrier Violations"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 in the last line (page 1, line 13 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$1,000" and inserting the following: '\$2,000'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report, provides that the total fine for violations of motor carrier laws for a motor carrier with no previous violation discovered during a compliance review may not exceed \$2,000, instead of \$1,000 as proposed in the bill.
