2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§96 is enacted to read:
3 4	96. Performing arts organizations. Sales to incorporated nonprofit performing arts organizations organized for the purpose of providing performing arts programs to a live
5 6	audience. For the purposes of this subsection, "performing arts program" means a performance, including a visual, graphic, musical, dance or theater presentation, in which
7	an artist uses body or voice to convey artistic expression.
8	Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act takes effect October 1, 2015.

10 11	This bill provides a sales tax exemption for sales to incorporated nonprofit performing arts organizations.
