4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to create a process to quantitatively evaluate a state contract to  
6 determine the total value of the contract to the State using multipliers for factors such as  
7 the amount of raw materials from in-state sources, the number of state residents employed  
8 and the use of vendors, consultants and subcontractors from the State to evaluate bids and  
9 existing contract performance and for general public information.
