L.D. 353, Bill, "An Act To Ensure Maine's Elver Fishermen Can Fully Access Maine's  
Elver Resource"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4.

SUMMARY

This amendment removes the requirement in Committee Amendment "A" that the  
Commissioner of Marine Resources submit the rules adopted, or a written justification for  
not adopting rules, that provide a method for authorizing a temporary medical transfer of  
the elver individual fishing quota allocated to the holder of an elver fishing license to  
another holder of an elver fishing license after March 1st to address emergency medical  
conditions to the Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources.
