Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 14 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 15 Whereas, this legislation allows sales representatives to serve alcoholic beverages at 16 tasting events; and 17 Whereas, it is necessary to implement this change immediately in order for it to be 18 in place for the summer tourist season; and 19 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within 20 the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 21 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 22 therefore.'' 23 Amend the amendment by adding before the summary the following: 24 'Amend the bill by adding before the summary the following: 25 Emergency clause.
