12 15 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "eligible" the following: 'and except
13 that a person who has been ineligible to receive benefits under the Temporary Assistance
14 for Needy Families program for 5 or more years may be considered eligible'

Incrementally Reduced Savings - General Fund

Fiscal Detail and Notes

Providing an exception that allows a person who has been ineligible for temporary assistance for needy families for 5 or more years to now be eligible to receive general assistance will reduce savings from the bill. The reduction is expected to be minor and overall the bill will continue to be savings to the General Assistance - Reimbursement to Cities and Towns program.
