COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 264, L.D. 398, Bill, "An Act To Allow Consumers of Cable Television To Purchase Channels Individually"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph F in the last line (page 1, line 4 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "individually" the following: ', except for channels included in the basic service tier'

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, retains the provision of the bill that requires a cable system operator to offer subscribers the option of purchasing access to cable channels individually and adds an exception for those channels that are provided in the basic service tier.
