**Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

**Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §3008, sub-§3, ¶F** is enacted to read:

F. Notwithstanding any provision in a franchise, a cable system operator shall offer subscribers the option of purchasing access to cable channels individually.
