1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6421, sub-§8, as amended by PL 2009, c. 213, Pt. G, §3, is further amended to read:
4	<b>8. Exception.</b> The fee for a license for an applicant $70 \pm 65$ years of age or older is:
5	A. For a Class I or an apprentice lobster and crab fishing license, \$66;
6	B. For a Class II lobster and crab fishing license, \$136; and
7	C. For a Class III lobster and crab fishing license, \$203.
8	SUMMARY
9 10	This bill lowers the age at which a person may obtain a lobster and crab fishing license for a reduced fee from 70 to 65 years of age.
