19 20	5. Penalty. Violation of this section is a traffic infraction, for which a forfeiture fine of not less than \$100 \$250 and not more than \$500 \$700 may be assessed.'

22 23 24 25 26	This amendment is one of 2 minority reports of the committee. This amendment replaces the bill, which concerns the failure to carry proof of motor vehicle financial responsibility. The amendment increases the minimum fine for failure to maintain financial responsibility from \$100 to \$250 and increases the maximum fine from \$500 to \$700.
