Development Districts for Municipalities and Plantations**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §5225, sub-§1, ¶B,** as amended by PL 2011, c. 101, §13, is
3 further amended to read:

4 B. Costs of improvements that are made outside the tax increment financing district
5 but are directly related to or are made necessary by the establishment or operation of
6 the district, including, but not limited to:

7 (1) That portion of the costs reasonably related to the construction, alteration or
8 expansion of any facilities not located within the district that are required due to
9 improvements or activities within the district, including, but not limited to,
10 sewage treatment plants, water treatment plants or other environmental protection
11 devices; storm or sanitary sewer lines; water lines; electrical lines; cellular
12 telephone towers; broadband infrastructure; improvements to fire stations; and
13 amenities on streets;

14 (2) Costs of public safety improvements made necessary by the establishment of
15 the district; and

16 (3) Costs of funding to mitigate any adverse impact of the district upon the
17 municipality or plantation and its constituents. This funding may be used for
18 public facilities and improvements if:

19 (a) The public facilities or improvements are located in a downtown tax
20 increment financing district; and

21 (b) The entire tax increment from the downtown tax increment financing
22 district is committed to the development program of the tax increment
23 financing district;

24 **SUMMARY**

25 This bill adds cellular telephone towers and broadband infrastructure to the list of
26 authorized project costs in the laws governing development districts for municipalities
27 and plantations.
