| 23<br>24             | 1. It retains the provision in the bill removing the requirement that a health care practitioner display a copy of the practitioner's license so the license is visible to patients.  |
| 25<br>26<br>27<br>28 | 2. It amends the requirement that a health care practitioner wear a name badge to clarify that either the practitioner's first name or first and last name may be disclosed, except for a physician, whose name badge must include the physician's first and last name. |
