A <u>If a health care practitioner sees patients in a setting outside of a licensed health care facility, a</u> health care practitioner shall display a copy of the practitioner's license in a prominent place in an office area visible to current and prospective patients. If the health care practitioner sees patients in a setting outside of a licensed health care facility, the <u>The</u> copy must be of sufficient size to be visible and apparent to patients, except that a copy no smaller than the original license is deemed to be sufficient. |
| 20 21 | B. A health care practitioner seeing patients on a face-to-face basis shall wear a name badge or some other form of identification that clearly discloses: |
| 22 23 24 | (1) The health care practitioner's <u>first name or first and last</u> name, <u>except that if</u> the heath care practitioner is a physician, the name badge or identification must disclose the physician's first and last name; and |
| 25 26 27 | (2) The type of license, registration or certification the health care practitioner holds, including the common term for the health care practitioner's profession; and. |
| 28 | (3) The health care practitioner's medical staff position, if applicable. |
| 29 | SUMMARY |
| 30 31 | This amendment is the minority report of the committee. The amendment does the following. |
| 32 33 | 1. It provides that only a health care practitioner that sees patients in a setting outside of a licensed health care facility is subject to the requirement that the health care |

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practitioner display a copy of the practitioner's license so the license is visible to patients. The majority report removes the requirement for all health care practitioners.

- 2. It amends the requirement that a health care practitioner wear a name badge to clarify that either the practitioner's first name or first and last name may be disclosed, except for a physician, whose name badge must include the physician's first and last name.
