An Act Concerning Commercial Vehicles at Canadian Weight Limits Traveling to Certain Points in the State

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §2354-C, sub-§1, ¶A, as amended by PL 2011, c. 356, §22,
 is further amended to read:

4 A. The only allowable routes of travel are from the United States-Canada border in 5 Calais north on U.S. Route 1 to Access Road in Baileyville, east on Access Road to Domtar Woodland Mill Pulp LLC mill or its successor on Main Street and north on 6 7 Main Street to the Louisiana Pacific Oriented Strand Board mill or its successor 8 former oriented strand board facility in Baileyville; from the United States-Canada border in Madawaska then directly north or south into the Fraser Papers Twin Rivers 9 facility or its successor in Madawaska or up Bridge Street to Mill Street in 10 Madawaska in order to reverse direction; and from the United States-Canada border 11 in Van Buren on Bridge Street, west to Main Street, also designated as Route 1, then 12 north on Main Street approximately 1 1/2 miles from the border. 13

- Sec. 2. 29-A MRSA §2354-C, sub-§1, ¶¶B and C, as enacted by PL 2009, c.
 326, §2, are amended to read:
- 16 B. Allowable truck configuration is limited to:

- (1) A 3-axle truck tractor with a 3-axle semitrailer at a gross vehicle weight of
 18 108,900 pounds. The individual weight distribution maximum limits are as
 19 follows: for the steering axle, 12,375 pounds; for the drive axles, 40,500 pounds;
 20 and for the semitrailer axles, 58,500 pounds, but in no case may the total of these
 21 values exceed 108,900 pounds; and
- (2) A 3-axle truck tractor with a semitrailer-semitrailer combination, configured
 as a B-train double with 8 axles total, at a gross vehicle weight of 137,700
 pounds. The weight of the 2nd semitrailer may not exceed the weight of the first
 semitrailer-<u>; and</u>
- 26(3) A 3-axle truck tractor with a 4-axle semitrailer at a gross vehicle weight of27122,380 pounds. The individual weight distribution maximum limits are as28follows: for the steering axle, 12,375 pounds; for the drive axles, 40,500 pounds;29and for the semitrailer axles, 72,000 pounds, but in no case may the total of these30values exceed 122,380 pounds.

C. Maine axle weight limits, axle group limits, commodity allowances, maximum dimensions and all other commercial vehicle limits and requirements apply, except that the B-train double overall length limit must be <u>not greater than</u> 82.02 feet, or 25 meters, and the 4-axle semitrailer length limit must be not greater than 53.15 feet, or 16.2 meters.

- SUMMARY
- This bill changes the weight limits that certain commercial vehicles may have when
 traveling from the United States-Canada border to certain points in the State.
