COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 384, L.D. 560, Bill, "An Act Regarding Patient Information Under the Maine Medical Use of Marijuana Act"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

**'Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2425, sub-§8, ¶M** is enacted to read:

M. The department may not store or retain in electronic format or require health care providers to transmit over the Internet personally identifying patient information related to this chapter, including the name, address and date of birth.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment replaces the concept draft with a provision that prohibits the Department of Health and Human Services from storing or retaining in electronic format or requiring health care providers to transmit over the Internet personally identifying patient information related to the Maine Medical Use of Marijuana Act, including the name, address and date of birth.
