1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §13104, sub-§16, as enacted by PL 2013, c. 588, Pt. E, §6 and
3	affected by §7, is amended to read:
4	16. Reciprocity. The commissioner shall allow a resident of a state that borders this
5	State to operate in this State a snowmobile that is registered in the bordering state if the
6	registration is valid and that state allows a snowmobile registered in this State to be
7	operated in that state. The commissioner may allow a nonresident to operate in this State
8	a snowmobile that is not registered in this State during one 3-consecutive-day period, 2
9	days of which are weekend days, annually if:
10	A. The nonresident's snowmobile has a valid registration from another state; and
11	B. The nonresident's state of residency allows a snowmobile registered in Maine to
12	be operated in that state for a period of time of at least 3 consecutive days without
13	being registered in that state.
14	This subsection may not be construed to authorize the operation of a snowmobile in a
15	manner contrary to this chapter except as provided in this subsection.
