Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill exempts from sales tax any fee placed on a paper or plastic single-use carry-out bag. The exemption will reduce General Fund revenue by \$9,144 in fiscal year 2014-15, \$33,250 in fiscal year 2015-16 and \$33,915 in fiscal year 2016-17. It will also reduce Local Government Fund revenue by \$481 in fiscal year 2014-15, \$1,750 in fiscal year 2015-16 and \$1,785 in fiscal year 2016-17.
