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9	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 415, L.D. 602, Bill, "An Act To
10	Amend the Laws Governing the Prohibition on the Sale of Motor Fuel Containing Corn-
11	based Ethanol"
12	Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 1, lines 4 to 10 in
13	L.D.) and inserting the following:
14	2. Contingent effective date. This section does not take effect until at least 10
15	other states or a number of states with a collective population of 30,000,000 3 of the other
16	New England states, Connecticut, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, Rhode Island and
17	Vermont, have enacted laws that prohibit the sale of motor fuel containing corn-based
18	ethanol. The Commissioner of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry shall notify the
19 20	Revisor of Statutes when 10 other states or a number of states having a collective population of 30,000,000 3 of the other New England states have adopted laws that
20	prohibit the sale of motor fuel containing corn-based ethanol.'
22	SUMMARY
23	This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, provides that the
24	prohibition on the sale of motor fuel containing corn-based ethanol does not take effect
25	until at least 3 of the other New England states, Connecticut, Massachusetts, New
26	Hampshire, Rhode Island and Vermont, have enacted laws that prohibit the sale of motor
27	fuel containing corn-based ethanol.
