SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 429,  
L.D. 616, Bill, "An Act Regarding the Sale of Hard Cider"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the substitute title the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

**Whereas,** this legislation must take effect before the expiration of the 90-day period so that it applies to this year's apple harvest; and

**Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Amend the amendment by adding before the summary the following:

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.'
