This amendment incorporates the 32 provisions of House Amendment "B" to Committee Amendment "A" and provides that a 33 person who is 18 years of age or older and under 21 years of age and is on active duty in 34

the Armed Forces of the United States or the National Guard or is an honorably

discharged veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States or the National Guard and is
